

This Indenture made this second day of June A. D. 1855, between Samuel Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence Kansas Territory, parties of the first part and Charles H. Smith, party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Charles H. Smith of said Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl October A. D. 1854 as follows: - to-wit: Share number twenty six (26) containing lots as follows: - Vermont Street thirteen (13) and ninety five (95) Tennessee Street one hundred fifty three (153) Massachusetts Street one hundred seventy six (176) Connecticut Street thirty three (33) Delaware Street fifty five (55) N. York Street one hundred fifty five (155) Mississippi Street two hundred sixty eight (268) and two hundred seventy (270) Delaware Street forty five (45) Maryland Street one hundred thirty one (131).

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we said Trustees our heirs or successors or any person claiming by from or under us or them shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to
