made we bind ourselves and our successors by these presents, now the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment by the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises, the said parties of the first part or their successor, shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second part his heirs or assigns a good and valid deed with the usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple whenever a patent for the Town Site of Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto one Robert Robitaille or William H. R. Lykins and be conveyed unto the aforesaid Trustees, then this obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force.

Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Michael Albin of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right, title, interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory and designated on the lithographed chart as surveyed by A. D. Stark, October A.D. 1854. as follows, to wit:
