Frazer of aforesaid place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto said Robert L. Frazer, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit: -

Lots no one hundred and seven (107) one hundred and nine (109) Louisiana Street according to a survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854.

And I Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of three hundred dollars to said Robert L. Frazer, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence or from any power or powers person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
