to me in hand paid by Francis L. Andre of aforesaid  
place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
have bargained, sold and quit-claimed and by  
these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto  
the said Francis L. Andre, his heirs, executors,  
administrators and assigns forever, all my right,  
title, interest, claim and demand in and to the fol-  
lowing described land, situate and lying in the City  
of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according  
to the survey made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854,  
to-wit: - Lot No. one hundred and eighty nine (189)  
Tennessee Street.

And I, Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, execu-  
tors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly  
bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred  
dollars to said Francis L. Andre, aforesaid, his heirs,  
executors, administrators and assigns to well and  
truly make over and convey unto him or him or  
them all the title which I shall receive from the  
Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any  
person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of  
the above described property, to have and to hold the  
same with all the privileges and appurtenances there-  
unto belonging, forever.
