Andre, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas to wit: Lot numbered one hundred and forty eight (148) Kentucky Street according to survey and plan made by A. D. Searl Oct. A. D. 1854.

And I the said J. Henry Muzzy my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to the said Francis L. Andre, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title such as the said J. Henry Muzzy shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
