Reynolds, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of ninety dollars to said Francis L. Andre, aforesaid, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. 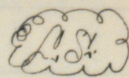
