Southmayd, of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said C. H. Southmayd, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:—

Lot No. two hundred and six (206) Tennessee Street. And I, John Mack, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of fifty dollars to said C. H. Southmayd aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence, or ^{from any} person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
