Leiby of New Port Perry County Pennsylvania the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said James B. Leiby, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas to wit: - Lot ninety-eight (98) New Hampshire Street according to survey and plan made by A. D. Searl Oct. A. D. 1854.

And the said Baker Guest my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred ten dollars, to the said James B. Leiby, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title such as the said Baker Guest shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above described property, To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
