D. Seabl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

" " Eighty nine Pennsylvania " (89)

And I, J. G. H. Hunt, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars to said G. A. Hunt, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make ^{over} and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
