 these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the
 said J. A. Finley, his heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns forever, all right, title, interest, claims
 and demands in and to the following described land,
 situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory
 of Kansas, to-wit: Lot No. fifty two (52) New
 Jersey Street City of Lawrence.

And I the said Howard York, my heirs, execu-
 tors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly
 bound by these presents in the sum of seventy-five dollars
 to the said James A. Finley, heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns to well and truly make
 over and convey unto him or them a good and valid
 title such as the said shall receive from the Trustees
 of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above
 described property. To have and to hold the same
 with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
 unto belonging, forever.
