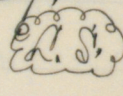

Goss, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot one hundred and sixty eight Indiana Street.

And I, Henry Bronson, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred & thirty dollars to said George W. Goss, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever.
