

This Indenture made this Second day of June A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchings Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part and George W. Goss party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said George W. Goss of said Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Beal October A.D. 1854, as follows: - to-wit: - Share number one hundred sixty nine (169) containing lots as follows, Vermont Street forty six (46) Ohio Street seventy five (75) Louisiana Street one hundred fourteen (144) and one hundred forty four (144) Indiana Street one hundred sixty five (165) New Jersey Street seventy two (72) Mississippi one hundred eighty (180) N. Jersey Street forty (40) Ohio Street one hundred seventy eight (178) and one hundred eighty (180) Delaware Street nineteen (19) and lot Connecticut Street sixty seven (67).

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither the said Trustees nor heirs or successors or any person claiming by from or under us or them shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof and we hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend against.
