D. Searl, <sup>Oct</sup> A. D. 1854, being the same lot drawn by S. F. Tappan on his share.

And I the said John B. Hood, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to the said C. H. Lovejoy, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title such as the said John B. Hood shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence, to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
