

This Indenture made this fourth day of May A.D. 1855
 between William B. Halling and Leonard G. Higgins of Law-
 rence, Kansas Territory, party of the first part and Francis
 Killam of Lawrence, said Territory, party of the second part
 witnesseth, that we the said William B. Halling and
 Leonard G. Higgins for and in consideration of the sum
 of two hundred and twenty dollars to us in hand paid by
 the said party of the second part, have sold, conveyed,
 released, and quit claimed unto the said party of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest
 in a certain lot of land situate in the Town and Territory
 aforesaid, and described on the Lithographed Chart as
 Surveyed by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1855, as follows, to-wit:

Lot number twenty one (21) New Hampshire Street.
 Together with the house thereon and all the privileges and
 appurtenances thereto belonging.

To have and to hold the aforesaid premises, together
 with the privileges thereto belonging unto the said party
 of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, so that
 neither we the said parties of the first part nor our heirs
 or assigns shall have claim or demand any right, title,
 or interest in or to the same or any part thereof, forever.
