

This Indenture made this second day of June A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part and Horace A. Hancock party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said Horace A. Hancock, of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Seale October A. D. 1854 as follows: - to-wit: - Share number nine (9) containing lots as follows: - Vermont Street sixteen (16) Louisiana Street one hundred nine (109) Kentucky Street One hundred thirty one Rhode Island Street one hundred eighteen (118) and one hundred twelve (117) Delaware Street seventy three (73) Tennessee Street two hundred one (201) and one hundred ninety nine (199) Illinois Street one hundred eighty eight (188) Pennsylvania Street one hundred thirty two (132) Pinckney Street thirty six (36) and lot Kentucky Street forty four (44). To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we said Trustees our heirs or successors or any person claiming by from or under us or them shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part
