 administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title,
 interest, claim and demand in and to the following
 described land situate and lying in the City of Law-
 rence in the Territory of Kansas, to wit, lot number
 one hundred eighty eight (188) on Connecticut street,
 according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A.D. 1854.

And I, the said E. D. Ladd, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly
 bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred
 dollars to the said Bennett Burnham his heirs, exec-
 utors, administrators and assigns to well and truly
 make over and convey unto him or them a good
 and valid title, such as the said Ladd, shall re-
 ceive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence, to any
 and all of the above described property, to have and
 to hold the same with all the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereto belonging, forever.
