 Territory of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot No. Forty two Pennsylvania St. Lawrence
 as laid out in the plat made by A. D. Searl made
 Oct. A. D. 1854.

And I, the said F. A. Hunt, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly
 bound by these presents in the sum of Fifty dol-
 lars to the said H. Campbell, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns to well and truly make
 over and convey unto him or them a good and
 valid title such as the said Hunt shall receive
 from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and
 all of the above described property. To have and
 to hold the same with all the privileges and ap-
 purtenances thereto belonging, forever.
