 of Kansas, according to the survey made by
 A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lot No. nine
 (9) Park.

And I, S. C. Harrington, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly
 bound, ^{by these presents} in the sum of two hundred dollars to said
 William H. Coffin, his heirs, executors, administrators,
 and assigns to well and truly make over
 and convey unto him or them all the title which
 I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of
 Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever,
 to any and all of the above described property.

To have and to hold the same with all the privi-
 leges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
