 Kansas, Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and
 by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto
 the said Erastus D. Ladd, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, forever, all our right,
 title, interest, claim and demand in and to
 the following described land situate and lying in
 the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas,
 to-wit: Lots numbered two hundred seventy
 two (272) Two hundred seventy four (274) Two
 hundred ninety eight (298) and Three hundred
 (300) all on Mississippi Street according to the
 Survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854.

And we the said Edward C. K. Garvey and Jane his
 wife our heirs, executors, administrators and
 assigns are held and firmly bound by these
 presents in the sum of Five hundred dollars to
 the said Erastus D. Ladd, his heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns to well and truly
 make over and convey unto him or them a good
 and valid title such as the said Garveys may or
 shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Law-
 rence or from any other person or persons whomsoever
 to any and all of the above described property.
 To have and to hold the same with all the privileges
 and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
