

This Indenture made this second day of June A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part and George W. Hutchinson party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the deed in trust from one William H. R. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by said George W. Hutchinson of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed and by these presents do convey, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October A.D. 1854, as follows, to-wit: - Share number one hundred thirty eight (138) containing Massachusetts Street eighty four (84) New Hampshire Street seventy nine (79) Kentucky Street one hundred twelve (112) Indiana Street two hundred thirty eight (238) and one hundred ninety nine (199) N. York Street one hundred twenty two (122) New Jersey Street one hundred five (105) Indiana Street two hundred eighty seven (287) Rhode Island Street one hundred sixty eight (168) and one hundred seventy (170) Maryland Street one hundred three (103) and lots Park four (4) and Massachusetts Street fifty (50.)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part so that neither we said Trustees our heirs or successors or any person claiming by from or under us or them shall have any right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof and we hereby covenant and agree,
