

This Indenture made this second day of June 255
A.D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover,
John P. Wood, William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson
Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory,
parties of the first part, and Owen Taylor, party of the
second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the
provisions contained in the deed in trust from one William
H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees and
in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid
by said Owen Taylor of said Town and Territory the re-
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, re-
leased, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey,
release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second
part, his heirs and assigns all right, title, and interest in and
to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence,
Trust Council District Kansas Territory and designated
on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl
October A. D. 1854, as follows, to-wit: Share number twenty
three (23) containing lots as follow: New Hampshire Street
forty (40) Vermont Street one hundred one (101) Tennessee
Street one hundred fifty nine (159) Massachusetts Street
one hundred seventy nine (179) Connecticut Street forty one
(41) Delaware Street fifty eight (58) N. York Street one hundred
fifty seven (157) and one hundred fifty nine (159) Missi-
ssippi Street two hundred seventy eight (278) Maryland
Street one hundred thirty seven (137) and one hundred thirty nine
(139) and lot Vermont Street six (6).

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the said party of the second part so that neither we
said Trustees our heirs or successors or any persons claim-
ing by from or under us or them shall have any right, title,
interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises,
or any part thereof and we hereby covenant and a-
gree to warrant and defend against all persons claim-
ing any right, title, or interest under the said Trustees, their heirs or
successors,
