D. Searl, A. D. 1854.

And I, Stillman Andrews, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of sixty dollars to said James B. Abbott, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence or from any other person or power whosoever to any and all of the above described property, To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
