

This Indenture made the second day of June 2976
A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P.
Hood, William H. R. Lykins and George H. Hutchinson, Trustees of the
Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first
part and Franklin L. Crane, party of the second part,
Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained
in the deed in trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above
Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar in hand paid by Franklin L. Crane of said
Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed, and by these
presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party
of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and
interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in
Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory and design-
ated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Seab
October A. D. 1854, as follows:—

To-wit:—Share number forty seven (47) containing Massa-
chusetts Street fifty five (55) Ohio Street seventy seven (77)
Connecticut Street twenty (20) Kentucky Street one hun-
dred fifty five (155) Connecticut Street seventy six (76) and
seventy eight (78) Indiana Street two hundred ninety one (291) and
two hundred ninety three (293) Illinois Street two hundred thirty
eight (238) Delaware Street one hundred thirty seven (137)
and one hundred thirty nine (139) and lot Pinkney Street
seventeen (17). To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed
premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing unto the said party of the second part, so that neither
we said Trustees our heirs or successors or any person
claiming by from or under us or them shall have any
right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid
premises or any part thereof; and we hereby covenant
and agree to warrant and defend against all persons
claiming any right, title, or interest under the said
Trustees their heirs or successors,
and further this Indenture Witnesseth that the said
