 do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said John W. Penoy-  
 er, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever,  
 all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the  
 following described land situate and lying in the Town of  
 Lawrence, Territory of Kansas to wit:- Lot numbered ninety  
 six (96) on New York Street according to survey and plan made  
 by A. D. Searl, Oct. A. D. 1854.

To have and to hold the same with all the privileges  
 and appurtenances thereto belonging forever, And I  
 the said John W. Penoyer, his heirs, executors, <sup>administrators</sup>  
 and assigns that I and my heirs, executors, and adminis-  
 trators shall and will warrant and defend the said prem-  
 ises to him and them against the lawful claims and de-  
 mands of all persons claiming by from or under us and  
 hereby bind myself and my heirs in the sum of two hundred <sup>dollars</sup>,  
 to the said John W. Penoyer, his heirs and assigns to convey  
 to him or them all further title which I may acquire  
 to the above described premises.
