administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by  
these presents in the sum of Two hundred and forty dollars  
to said A. G. Saunders, aforesaid, his heirs, executors,  
administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over

ceive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence  
or from any power, or person or persons whatsoever, to any
