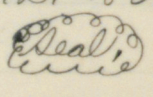


Know all Men by these Presents that I, Silas Green of the City of Lawrence and Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars, to me in hand paid by James Leibey, ^{M.D.} of said Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said James Leibey his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit:- Lot numbered sixty eight (68) on New Hampshire Street, according to survey and plan made by A. D. Searl, Oct. A.D. 1854.

And I the said Silas Green, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of four hundred dollars to the said James Leibey, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over, and convey unto him or them a good and valid title such as the said Silas Green shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence, to any and all of the above described property, To have and to hold, the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
