Lot number Thirty five (35) New Jersey Street.
And I the said Robert O. Gibbons, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and
firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One
hundred (\$100) dollars, to the said James Mayhood
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
to well and truly make over and convey unto
him or them a good and valid title such as
the said Gibbons shall receive from the Trustees
of the City of Lawrence to any and all
of the above described property, To have and
to hold the same with all the privileges and
appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
