Lot No. Thirty five (35) New Jersey Street, according to a survey made by A. D. Kearl, A. D. 1854.

And I the said James Mayhood, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two hundred dollars, to the said Moore & Brothers, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title, such as the said James Mayhood shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
