D. Searl, Oct. 1854.

And I the said C. H. Lovejoy, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound, by these presents in the sum of Two hundred fifty dollars to the said Lydia Hall, her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title, such as the said Lovejoy shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto, belonging, forever.
