

Know all men by these presents, That I, John Baldwin
of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, for and in consideration
of the sum of Fifty Five dollars to me in hand paid
by John B. Wood, of said Lawrence, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, having bargained, sold,
and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain
sell, and quit-claim unto the said John B. Wood,
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever,
all my right, title, interest, claim and demand
in and to the following described land situate and
lying in Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, to-wit: - Lot
number eighty five (85) on New York Street according
to survey and plan made by A. D. Searl, Oct. A.D. 1854.
To have and to hold the same with all the privileges
and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
And I, John Baldwin do hereby covenant with the
said John B. Wood, his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns; that I and my heirs, executors, and
administrators shall and will warrant and defend
the said premises to him and them against the
lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming
by from or under us and I hereby bind myself
and my heirs in the sum of one hundred dollars to
make over to said Wood his heirs or assigns any further
title which I may receive to said lot. In witness
