Searl, in 1854, in the town of Lawrence K. T., And I, John P. Hood, aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, to Aaron Perry, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever to and all of the above described property.
