 be paid into the said James S. Emery, his heirs or  
 assigns to which payment well and truly to be made  
 we bind ourselves and our successors by these presents.  
 Now the condition of this obligation is such  
 that if upon the payment by the said party of  
 the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the  
 aforesaid premises the said parties of the first part or their  
 successors shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second  
 part his heirs or assigns a good and valid deed with the usual con-  
 ventions for conveyance in less simple whenever a patent  
 for the Town Site of Lawrence shall issue from  
 Congress unto one Robert Robitaille or William
