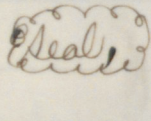

Hall of Lawrence K.T., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these Presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim ~~and~~ unto the said Lydia Hall, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate, and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A.D. 1854, Lots number two hundred and eighty nine (289) and two hundred and ninety one (291) Mississippi Street. And George F. Earle, aforesaid, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of eighty dollars to said Lydia S. Hall, aforesaid, her heirs, executors, administrators, to well and truly make over and convey unto her or them all the which he shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property.
