claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell,
and quit-claim unto the said Louisa B. Bigelow,
her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and
demand in and to the following described
land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence,
in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit: Lot number
Two hundred and thirty one, ^{on Ohio Street} as given on the
map of said City surveyed by A. D. Searl, in
Oct. 1854. And I the said George H. Brown
my heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of One hundred dollars
to the said Louisa B. Bigelow, her heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns to well and truly
make over and convey unto her or them a good
and valid title such as the said George H.
Brown shall receive from the Trustees of the
City of Lawrence, to any and all of the above
described property. To have and to hold the
same with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereunto belonging, forever.
