

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Henry Campbell, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph E. Wilson of Yellow Spring Green County Ohio the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Joseph E. Wilson, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, a. d. 1854, to-wit: - Lots No. Thirtieth three (33) Pinckney Street and one hundred and thirty-eight (138) and two hundred and twenty-two (222) and two hundred and twenty-four (224) Louisiana Street and eighty seven (87) Rhode Island Street. And I, Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Nine hundred dollars to said Joseph E. Wilson aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
