

Know all men by these Presents That I, Lewis Howell  
of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in 445.  
consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me  
in hand paid by Erastus D. Ladd, of Lawrence, aforesaid, the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold,  
and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain,  
sell, and quit-claim unto the said Erastus  
D. Ladd, to his heirs and assigns, forever, all my  
right, title, estate, interest, claim and demand,  
in possession or in expectancy of in and to the  
following described land situate in the Town of  
Lawrence, aforesaid, to-wit: Lot number Fifty  
seven (57) on Louisiana Street according to  
the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854.

To have and to hold the above described premises,  
with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto  
belonging unto the said Ladd, heirs and assigns  
forever. And I the said Lewis Howell, for myself  
and my heirs, executors and administrators  
do covenant with the said Erastus D. Ladd his  
heirs and assigns that the said premises are  
free from all encumbrances made or  
suffered by me. That I have full right and  
power to sell, convey and quit-claim the same,  
and that I shall and will warrant and defend  
the same unto the said Ladd, and to his heirs and assigns  
forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all  
persons claiming by through or under me but against  
none other. And I the said Howell, my heirs and assigns  
are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum  
of two hundred Dollars to the said Ladd, his heirs, executors,  
and administrators to make and convey unto him or them  
all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed  
to me by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title  
to the Town Site of Lawrence, aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office,
