This Indenture made this second day of June A. D. 1855,
 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Groves, John P. Hood, William
 H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town
 Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part,
 and Albert D. Searl, party of the second part Witnesseth,
 that in compliance with the provisions contained in the
 deed in trust from one William H. R. Lykins to the above
 Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration
 of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by Albert D. Searl
 of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed,
 and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim
 unto the said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns all right, title, and interest in and to certain
 lots of land situate and being in Lawrence, First Council
 District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the lithogr-
 aphed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, Oct. A. D. 1855. as
 follows, to-wit: Lot New Hampshire Street Fifteen (15)
 To have and to hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises
 with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing unto the said party of the second part, so that neither
 said Trustees nor ^{heirs or} successors or any person claiming by
 from or under us or them shall have any
 right, title, interest, claim or demand in or to the
 aforesaid premises or any part thereof. And whereby
 covenant and agree to warrant and defend against
 all persons claiming any right, title, or interest
 under the said Trustees, their heirs or successors,
