Robinson, of Lawrence, aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said C. Robinson, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all our right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit:-

The north half of Lot No. One Massachusetts Street.

And we the said Campbell and Simpson, or heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the said C. Robinson, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him a good and valid title such as the said Campbell and Simpson shall receive from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence, to any and all of the above described property.

To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
