 and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and
 demand in and to the following described land situate
 and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas
 according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:
 Lots number one hundred and sixty two (162) and One
 hundred and sixty four (164) Indiana Street.
 And I, H. M. Simpson, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred dollars to said
 Amos Hadsorth, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, admini-
 strators and assigns to well and truly make over and
 convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive
 from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any
 power or person or persons whosoever to any and all of the
 above described property, to have and to hold the same
 with all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
