Frazer his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claims and demands in and to the following described land Situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas to wit:

Lots no. One hundred and seven (107) - one hundred and nine ~~of~~ Louisiana Street according to a survey made by A. D. Seaver et al. 1854

And I Henry Campbell aforesaid my heirs Executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of three hundred dollars to said Robert L. Frazer aforesaid his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make and convey unto him or them all the title I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence or from any person or persons person or persons who or who to any and all of the above described property To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever
