Andre his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever all my right like interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by C. D. Smith et al. 1854 to wit: Lot no. One Hundred and eighty nine (189) Main Street

and I Henry Campbell aforesaid my heirs Executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these Presents in the sum of One Hundred dollars to the said Francis L. Andre aforesaid his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make good and comply with him or him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any person or persons whatsoever to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever
