

This Indenture made this second day of June
A.D. 1855. Between Samuel S. Snyder Joel Green John P. Miller
William H. R. Lykin and George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the
Town site of Lawrence Kansas Territory parties of the first
part and Franklin S. Crane party of the second part
Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in
the deed in trust from one William H. R. Lykin to the above
Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the
sum of one dollar in hand paid by Franklin S. Crane of said
Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have conveyed released and quit claimed and by these pre-
sents do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of
the second part this heirs and assigns all right title and inter-
est in and to certain lot of land situated and being in Law-
rence Just Council District Kansas Territory and design-
ated on the Lithographer's chart as surveyed by A. D. Seale
October A.D. 1854 as follows:-

To wit: Square numbered forty seven (47) containing Massa-
chusetts Street fifty five (55) Ohio Street Seventy seven (77)
Connecticut Street twenty (20) Kentucky Street one hun-
dred fifty five (155) Connecticut Street Seventy six and seven-
ty eight (78) Indiana Street two hundred ninety one (291) and
two hundred ninety three (293) Illinois Street two hundred thirty
eight (238) Delaware Street one hundred thirty seven (137)
and one hundred thirty nine (139) and lot Pintney Street
Seventeen (17)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises
with all the privilege and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the said party of the second part so that neither
we said Trustees nor heirs or successors or any person
claiming by heirs or assigns nor them shall have any
right title interest claim or demand in or to the aforesaid
premises or any part thereof; and we hereby covenant
and agree to warrant and defend against all person
claiming any right title or interest in the said pre-
mises their heirs or successors

And further this Indenture Witnesseth that the said
E. J. L. and R.
