S. Hall her heirs executors administrators and
assigns forever all my right title interest claim
and demand in and to the following described
land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence
in the Territory of Kansas to wit Lot number One
hundred and Eighty seven (187) on New Hampshire
Street according to Survey and plan made by
A. P. Webb Oct 20. 1834 being the same lot
purchased of Otis Patten as by his deed of even date
herewith will appear - And the said George W. Hunt
my heirs executors administrators and assigns
are held and firmly bound by these presents in the
sum of One Hundred Dollars to the said Lydia S.
Hall her heirs executors administrators and assigns
to well and truly make over and convey unto her or
them a good and valid title such as the said George
W. Hunt shall receive from the Trustees of the City
of Lawrence to any and all of the above described
property to have and to hold the same with all the
privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
