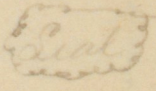


From all men by these presents that S. M. J. Longjoy of the

 of Kansas to wit Lot number one hundred
 and sixty five (165) on Kentucky Street according
 to plan and survey made by A. D. Seavey Feb 4. 1857
 and to the said Charles J. Longjoy my heirs exec-
 utors administrators and assigns are sold and
 forever bound by these presents in the sum of
 Two Hundred Dollars to the said Lydia S. Hall
 her heirs executors administrators and assigns
 to well and truly make over and convey unto him or
 them a good and valid title such as the said S.
 J. Longjoy shall receive from the Trustees of the City
 of Lawrence to any and all of the above described
 property he now and to hold the same with all
 the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing forever - In witness whereof I have hereunto
