Sum of Seventy five dollars to me in hand paid by
A.J. Klein hereof of Lawrence the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and
quit claimed and by these Presents do bargain sell
and quit claim unto the said Klein hereof his heirs
executors administrators and assigns forever all
my right title interest claim and demand in and
to the following described land Situate and lying
in the Town of Lawrence of Kansas to wit Lots Number
One Hundred and Sixty (16) and One Hundred and
Eighty (18) on Pennsylvania Street Do have and to
hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereto belonging forever And I P.H. Woodward do
hereby covenant with the said A.J. Klein hereof his
heirs executors administrators and assigns that I
and my heirs executors and administrators shall and will
warrant and defend the said premises to him and them
against the lawful claims and demands of all
persons claiming by force or under us. In Witness whereof
