tion of the sum of One Thousand and Sixty Five Dollars
and half and paid her by James S. Moore of Peoria
Illinoes the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
I do acknowledge sold said land to him and by
these presents do acknowledge and confirm
unto the said Elizabeth Simons his wife in regard of
Administration and signature given all rights
the interest & claim of the said wife in regard to the
foregoing described land situated and lying in
the State of Illinois in the Township of West Liberty
according to the survey made by C. D. Lewis
on the 2d of April A. D. 1834 to viz. about Sixty Six P. M. Cherokeetown
and east in Creek bed and running southwardly
and dividing the tract of land in said town
by which present administration and signature
be held and jointly bound by the said wife to in-
troducing of him & his wife, where to said farm
she may go and for the better enjoyment of his wife
to let him and assign to sell and convey all or
any or so much land or part of the same as he
shall desire among the trustees of his said Lot
of Land according to the survey made by C. D. Lewis
whensoever he may sell all of the above described
property or shall cause to hold the same with all the
privileges and advantages thereunto belonging
