or assigns a good and valid Receipt with the same
certificates for carrying in full payment of the
apportion for the term of six years shall issue
from Congress unto our Robert H. Bell and William
H. Ricketts and be conveyed unto the aforesaid
Debtors then this obligation shall be void and of
no effect otherwise to remain in full force
