Preamble

We the undersigned, feeling the importance of an institution whose object shall be the encouragement of Literature and the Fine Arts, and believing such conducive to the best interests of Kansas, do hereby form ourselves into a Literary Association and adopt the following

Constitution.

Article First - Title.

The name of this Association shall be The Kansas Atheneum.

Article Second - Officers

The officers of this Association shall consist of one President, two Vice Presidents, a Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Librarian and a Board of Regents, consisting of five, all of whom shall be elected annually by ballot.

Article Third - Duties of Officers

Sect. 1st It shall be the duty of the President or, in his absence, of one of the Vice Presidents to preside over all meetings of the Association and maintain all rules established by Parliamentary usage.

Sect. 2^d It shall be the duty of the Recording Secretary to give notice of all meeting and keep a correct record of the same, and to notify persons of their election.

Sect. 3^e The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct
