Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration  
of Sixty Dollars and fifty Cents Dollars, in  
hand paid by the said party of the second part, (the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the second part forever released and  
discharged therefrom,) have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened,  
and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien,  
and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns  
forever, all the following described lots, pieces or parcel of land, situated and  
being in the Town of Endora, in the county of Douglas, and Territory of  
Kansas, to wit: Lot Two  $\frac{1}{2}$  in Block Two hundred and fourteen  $\frac{1}{2} \text{ Acre}$ ,  
Lot Fifteen  $\frac{1}{4}$  in Block Seventy three  $\frac{1}{2} \text{ Acre}$ .

administrators, do covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second  
part, his heirs and assigns, that the above bargained premises, in the quiet  
and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and  
assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming, or to claim  
the whole or any part thereof they shall and will Warrant and Forever Defend.
