Pfeif and Elisabeth, his wife, of the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois, and Charles Querr, of the City of Eudora, County of Douglas, and Territory of Kansas, parties of the first part, and Peter Freund, of the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of Fifteen Dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the second part forever released and discharged therefrom, I have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien, and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described lots, pieces or parcels of land, situate, lying and being, in the Town of Eudora, in the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas, to wit:

Lot Two $\frac{1}{2}$ in Block One hundred and Eighty seven $\frac{1}{2}$

Lot Fourteen $\frac{1}{4}$ in Block Forty six $\frac{1}{4}$

as described in Map of Eudora, and filed in the Records Office of said Douglas County.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances, thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever of the said parties of the first part, either in law or equity, of, in, and to the above bargained premises, with the hereditaments and appurtenances, To Have and to Hold the said premises above bargained and described
